

Natural gas dryers save energy and your clothes

Today's high-efficiency natural gas clothes dryers are made to save energy and be kind to your clothes. An energy-efficient natural gas dryer costs less to operate than an electric dryer — up to 50 percent less! And with the cost of clothing today, it makes sense to protect your investment by using a dryer that is easy on your clothes.

Energy savings

Gas dryers do not have the familiar EnergyGuide labels you see on other appliances, so look for these features for maximum energy efficiency:

- **Pilotless ignition** means the unit does not have a continuously burning pilot light, so you use less energy.
- **Insulation and polymer-coated drum seals** keep the heat inside the drum, reducing wasted heat and keeping your house cooler.
- **Lint filter to trap lint** keeps air flowing freely to your dryer. A clogged lint filter will reduce the efficiency of the dryer, so remove the built-up lint after each use. Look for models with easy access to the lint filter.

Handle with care

Gas clothes dryers come loaded with energy-saving features designed to pamper your clothes.

- **Moisture sensor controls** detect moisture in clothing. When the clothing is dry, the dryer stops. Not only does this feature save energy, it means fewer wrinkles and less shrinkage due to over-drying. And you won't have to keep checking the dryer to see if your clothes are dry yet.

- **Automatic cool down** cycles and after-cycles tumble clothes without heat at the end of the cycle to reduce wrinkling — and reduce the time you spend ironing!
- **Diagonal airflow patterns** provide fast, thorough drying at lower temperatures, saving money and wear and tear on your clothing.
- **Drying racks or baskets** are handy for clothing and canvas shoes that don't need to be tumbled.
