### Natural gas patio heaters

With a natural gas-fired infrared patio heater, the outdoor season around the pool, patio, or even the marina lasts months longer. These infrared units radiate heat that warms objects and people the same way the sun warms the earth.

Patio heaters are most effective in ranges from 12 to 20 feet and at outdoor temperatures of 50 to 70 degrees Fahrenheit.

Both permanent and portable models are available for residential and commercial use.
